REMOTE PILOT KNOWLEDGE TEST PREP

To legally operate a drone for any business purpose, FAA regulations now require remote pilot certification. This course prepares you to successfully pass the comprehensive FAA knowledge test. Topics covered include regulations, airspace, weather, loading and performance, and operations. The course fee includes a workbook, 50 FAA sample test questions, and six hours of instruction. Certification testing must be administered at an authorized FAA Knowledge Testing Center and is NOT included in the course fee.

NEW! LEARNING TO FLY DRONES & FAA PART 107 TEST PREP

Learn drone flight basics and gain the knowledge needed to pass the FAA Part 107 UAV Test. This course is designed the rules commercial and hobbyist use. In addition to learning basic operation and flight functions for today's best and most widely used drones, students will learn the FAA rules and regulations regarding UAV flight, flight chart reading, air traffic communication, aviation weather, flight restrictions, drone safety protocols, risk management, and more. Classes will be divided between flight and traditional classroom instruction. DronePix, the facilitator of the course, will have a limited number of drones available to loan students who do not have their own. Depending on course enrollment and students needing loaner UAVs, flight time may be limited. Students will be taught using DJI Spark and Mavic Pro drones. Students are encouraged to bring and use their own UAV if it fits within the specifications: it must have the ability to fly outdoors and have established GPS stabilization to satellite capabilities. All Drones are required to have propeller guards and have two batteries which will allow flight for a minimum of 30 minutes. Students wish to purchase a drone before, during, or after the course or need additional information pertaining to the course, please call **DronePix at 845-691-7567**.

After registering for the course all students will be sent a short questionnaire to help evaluate their level of drone experience. *Course does not include FAA Part 107 Exam, which is only administered by the FAA.

NEW! DRONES FOR ENGINEERS

Drone video and photographs are seen in many of today's movies, television shows and commercials. Hobbyists and professionals are using aerial technology for fun and profit. The Federal Aviation Administration recently issued its part 107 rules for small unmanned aircraft system drones. Remote pilots flying for commercial pay or profit (including YouTube ads) must be certified after passing that 107 FAA test. Business flight missions meeting these standards are emphasized. This introductory course presents engineering applications where drones can save money over conventional methods of data gathering. Surveying, construction monitoring, bridge & infrastructure inspection topics are covered, as are the basics of drone flying and video editing, plus FAA rules and privacy concerns. A drone will be demonstrated, but not flown in the classroom. This course offers 6.5 PDHs to professional engineers. **Instructor: P. Tavino Jr. P.E.**

SECURITY GUARDS



8-HOUR ANNUAL INSERVICE TRAINING

This course must be completed each calendar year you hold a security guard registration. Your registration is issued for two years, therefore, you must complete two eight-hour annual Inservice training courses within your registration effective and expiration dates to be eligible for application renewal. The course is structured to provide the student with updated and enhanced information on the duties and responsibilities of a security guard.

8-HOUR PRE-ASSIGNMENT TRAINING

New York State requires the licensing of all security guards or personnel acting in security functions. Ulster BOCES is approved by the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services to offer the mandated eight-hour pre-assignment training programs. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive an official course completion certificate. Saturday class: it is recommended to bring a bag lunch. NOTE: Completion of this course is only one of the requirements to be a licensed security guard. Students must file an application with NYS and be fingerprinted for which there are additional fees.
